Perpetrators

Victims

17% had been victims of domestic violence in the past

Perpetrators who had problems with:

- 9% alcoholism
- 6% gambling
- 7% drug use
- 17% extramarital affairs

56% were married
19% were separated

Youth Victims

42% psychological violence
7% psychological and physical violence
2% neglect
4% psychological and sexual violence

Services Provided

344 Attended counselling meetings
1292 Received support through our Helpline
72 stayed at the shelter

SPAVO handled **1636** cases

639 of which were new

636 of the cases were old

For **361** cases it wasn't mentioned if they were new or old

73 asked for shelter for the victims

199 victims were minors

78% Cypriot

80% men

15% women

2% were minors

In **84%** of the cases there was a female victim

24 were pregnant

56% were abused by their spouse or partner

12% were abused by a former spouse or partner

18% were either the daughter or mother of their perpetrator

76% lived with the perpetrator

70% had children

40% psychological violence

52% psychological and physical violence

6% psychological, physical and sexual violence

1% psychological and sexual violence

1% neglect

85% reported the violence had occurred more than once

28% experienced violence at a young age

25% were unemployed
